


**AMES's lines of action in environmental issues are characterized by:**

**And applying the criteria of POLLUTION PREVENTION, SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT:**

- Management of energy, water and raw materials, always seeking their optimization and therefore, their saving, which entails.
  - Promoting the use of clean energies by obtaining energy supply agreements from renewable sources or low CO2 footprint.
  - Improving the energy efficiency of our processes and facilities.
  - Recycle and reuse internally, both process waters and the products and products and raw materials necessary for our activity, making a responsible management of the chemical substances that may be involved.
- Improve the environmental performance of our activities, reducing greenhouse gas emissions and therefore taking into account this point and the previous ones in the selection of new equipment or production processes that may be necessary.
- Minimisation and reuse of waste and, ultimately, recycling and/or management by authorised companies.
- To train and sensitize the employees on environmental issues.
- Implement a Management System that can meet the requirements of the ISO-14001 standard.

These lines of action will be specified in quantifiable objectives in each of the group's plants.
